- Applicant is the fee owner or can provide written consent from the fee owner granting permission for the cultivation of industrial hemp on the specified parcel(s).

YES NO The outer edges of the planned hemp crop, measured from the base of the hemp plants, is:

- i. A minimum of fifty feet from any and all property lines of any adjoining parcel under different ownership.
- ii. A minimum of one hundred-feet from the edge of pavement for any and all county-maintained roads.
- iii. A minimum of two hundred feet from any and all legal dwellings located on a parcel under different ownership. The nearest point of the dwellings utilized for interior living space shall be the point of measurement to determine the dwelling setback requirement.
- iv. Not within one thousand feet of the boundary of a school, as defined in the ordinance.

The application shall be accompanied by a legible and detailed map indicating parcel boundaries, ownership of dwellings within setbacks, adjoining parcel ownership information, and all applicable measured setback distances for all proposed or existing hemp cultivation sites.

Setback exception: Registrants that received a license during the initial pilot program (2019) or the extended pilot program (2020), maintained that license in an active status, and have annually renewed that license in consecutive years are not subject to setbacks adopted in the permanent ordinance (2021), provided that there are no alterations to the prior approved cultivation site(s).

I qualify for the above exception, and elect not to have setbacks applied to my existing cultivation site(s) with the understanding that any changes made to a previously approved cultivation site(s) or addition of other cultivation sites will cause setbacks to apply to **ALL** cultivation sites under that specific license. This may result in forced removal of industrial hemp plants that do not meet setback standards.
