V. StanCOG TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX INITIATIVE

Public Works Director Matt Machado shared information regarding the Stanislaus County proposed tax measure. He gave a brief overview about transportation funding, stating road maintenance is funded by gas tax revenue which has gone down this year and further reduction is expected again next year, partially due to lower gas prices and other factors. Additionally, vehicle miles traveled are up, so wear & tear on roads is high. The Stanislaus Council of Governments has proposed an Expenditure Plan based on a 25-year ½ cent sales tax measure for consideration by voters on the November 2016 ballot. The proposed tax measure is intended to seek additional funding to be distributed to local agencies to fund various transportation projects. Mr. Machado's presentation focused on the expenditure plan for the use of Stanislaus County's share of the program which would be broken into five categories: Local Streets & Roads; Regional Projects; Traffic Management; Bicycle / Pedestrian; and Other. It is noted that this expenditure plan is still in the draft stage and is not final.
