## J: 1,3-Dichloropropene

Changes in regulations to 1,3-Dichloropropene went into effect on January 1, 2024. Stanislaus County has implemented the conditional requirements, outlined in **TABLE 1**, to properly evaluate proposed uses of 1,3-Dichloropropene in accordance with Volume 3 of the California Department of Pesticide Regulation (CDPR)'s Pesticide Use Enforcement Program Standards Compendium, Appendix J. The 1,3-Dichloropropene regulations and compendium documents are available on CDPR's website and can be accessed by scanning the relevant QR Codes on the **CDPR REFERENCE DOCUMENTS TABLE**.

Notice of Intents (NOI)	<ul> <li>Must be submitted to Stanislaus County 96 hours prior to the proposed application date. For fumigations proposed for a Monday, the NOI must be received by Tuesday prior.</li> <li>Must identify the Product Name and EPA Reg. No.</li> <li>Must specify the Fumigation Method</li> <li>Must include Calculations outlining the Broadcast Equivalency Rate (e.g. Treatment Width, Row Spacing, Percentage of Active Ingredient)</li> <li>Must include <u>ALL</u> applicable signed Vacate Agreements* with neighboring property operators.</li> <li>Must include Maps of the application site identifying the following:</li> <li>Distances to all structures/sensitive sites/difficult to evacuate sites</li> <li>Setback distances from occupied structures</li> <li>Outline of area within the field where setbacks will be maintained.</li> <li>Structures with Vacate Agreements must be referenced.</li> <li>Permit Number and Site Identification Number</li> <li>Treatment Blocks and Acreage</li> </ul>	
Field Conditions	<ul> <li>Must include a copy of the Pest Control Recommendation</li> <li>The following field conditions must be met at the time of NOI Submission</li> <li>Soil moisture and temperature in compliance with Appendix J and/or Label requirements</li> <li>Free of debris and in good tilth (Ready for application)</li> <li>Setbacks within the field must be flagged/marked</li> </ul>	
Site-Specific Permit Conditions	Applications of 1,3-Dichloropropene may not proceed until site-specific permit conditions have been issued and approved by the Stanislaus County Agricultural Commissioner's Office.
